**Date/Time:** April 12, 2016 / 8:00 a.m.

**Location:** Parking Lot "D" Fresno City College

**Suspect:** #1 Hispanic male, 20's, 5'10", 175 lbs, clean cut, wearing a black baseball cap, black shirt and black jeans

#2 Hispanic male, 20's, 5'-8", wearing a black and grey sweatshirt and dark colored jeans

**Vehicle:** Black Honda CRX, 2 door, with black taillights

At approximately 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, April 12, 2016, a Fresno City College student was approached by two (2) Hispanic males in parking lot "D" that demanded he turn over his backpack to them. The victim refused, at which time the two (2) Hispanic males began striking him in the face with closed fists. The victim fought back and the suspects fled from parking lot "D" in a 2 door, black Honda CRX, with black taillights. The suspects were last seen exiting parking lot "D" onto westbound McKinley Avenue.

Due to this crime occurring at Fresno City College, there is a concern for the safety and welfare of the students, faculty, staff and visitors of the campus. We urge all students, faculty and staff to be aware of their surroundings while walking to or from their vehicles in any of the parking lots.
